24/03/11 AM Began litter pick at Clarkson Rd up to the triangle then along the railway footpath covering part of Spencer Close large plastic bag of bottles found along here. Progressed onto Station Road then Post Office Road, found a dead cat on the top of the verge not far from the children's play area. I have reported this to environmental services for possible disposal action. Cleaned up around the Millennium Green play area and field lots of sweet wrappers collected. Continued collecting various litter along Chapel Road up to the railway crossing then into Orchard Close.

24/03/11 PM Visited playing field and teen shelter opposite the village hall collected a large amount of litter in this area comprising: plastic bottles, bags and fast food packaging etc.

Noticed the builders rubble mentioned in my previous report (11) 8/3/11 is still there. So I have contacted environmental services to see if they will agree to collect it when they empty the litter bin on Tuesdays.

Continued along Norwich Road clearing rubbish from the verge up to Avondale Road. Finished collecting on Station Road.

30/03/11 Started at Clarkson Road continued onto Station Rd, then the footpath to Granary Close the usual bottles, drink cans, crisp packets picked up. Next we visited the Millennium Green and play area lots of sweet papers collected. Some pizza packages and other rubbish cleared up from the pit area near the gate on the corner of Post Office Road. Visited the village pond and removed some bottles and other plastic debris found floating on the surface.

Pleased to report that whilst collecting today I noticed that the dead cat and the fly tipped rubble sacks mentioned previously have all now been removed by Broadland environmental services. A thank you email has been sent to the team.

02/04/11 Yes it's back again like a recurring nightmare! Audio cabinet, Gerbil cage and Vacuum cleaner hose packed in a blue plastic bucket with other rubbish.

It would appear that some irresponsible people are using this area as an unofficial rubbish tip, risking a possible £2000 for fly tipping.

The cabinet, cage and blue plastic bucket have all now been removed and recycled. Picked up litter around the teen shelter and playing field then along Station Road.
