7-04-11 Early evening litter pick starting at Clarkson Road then progressed onto Station Road collected cans, plastic bottles and crisp packets found mainly along the grass verge opposite the walkway. Next collected litter along the footpath to Granary Close then onto the Millennium Green via the footpath from the top of Post Office Close. Collected drink cans, sweet wrappers and cigarette packets from the field and play area. Untangled and removed several plastic supermarket shopping bags from the surrounding hedges.

08-04-11 Started at Glebe Farm on Acle Road working back towards the village via Lodge Road collected various scattered rubbish from the hedges and verges that had presumably been thrown from passing vehicles. A significant amount of litter was picked up in this area, by the time we reached Station Road 2 large bags had been filled.

We then collected along Post Office Road finishing on Post Office Close.

11-04-11 Visited the Millennium Green and play area. Enlisted the help of two curious children who asked me about what I was doing and enthusiastically joined in especially when I lent them the pick up stick which they had fun using. Collected the usual litter plus a used disposable barbecue. Pleased to see that all the litter bins on the green were full and will be emptied tomorrow. Next visited the village hall playing field, car park and teen shelter cleaned up a broken glass bottle in the shelter plus the usual empty beer cans and fast food packaging

17-04-11 Collected along Station Road from the railway crossing up the Village Hall. Progressed on to the playing field and car park also cleaned out the youth shelter and drainage ditches. Picked up the usual cans, bottles and fast food packaging with plastic cutlery.

Next along Norwich Road and into Highway then back onto Norwich Road. Quite a bit of rubbish collected on the shop car parks. Noticed the bin outside the Spar shop was full and overflowing. Finished picking on Chapel Road at the railway crossing.

18-04-11 Returned to the Millennium Green and noticed several patches of grass have been burnt by the use of BBQ's This is evident in several parts of the field including the middle. The usual range of litter was collected and finding more of it now that the good weather has arrived.

Also visited the Church car park and vicinity and this was found to have stayed surprisingly free of rubbish since our last visit on the 4th March.
